4. Official training sessions

Saturday/Sunday:

Children's race: possible up to 30 minutes before the start

XC & XCM course: Saturday from 1 p.m. (outside the start and finish areas)

5. Insurance & Conduct during the race

Insurance is the responsibility of the participants. The organiser cannot be held liable for any damage of any kind.

All participants must be covered by adequate health, accident and civil liability insurance.

All participants must comply with Swiss road traffic regulations (LCR) throughout the race and before and after the race.

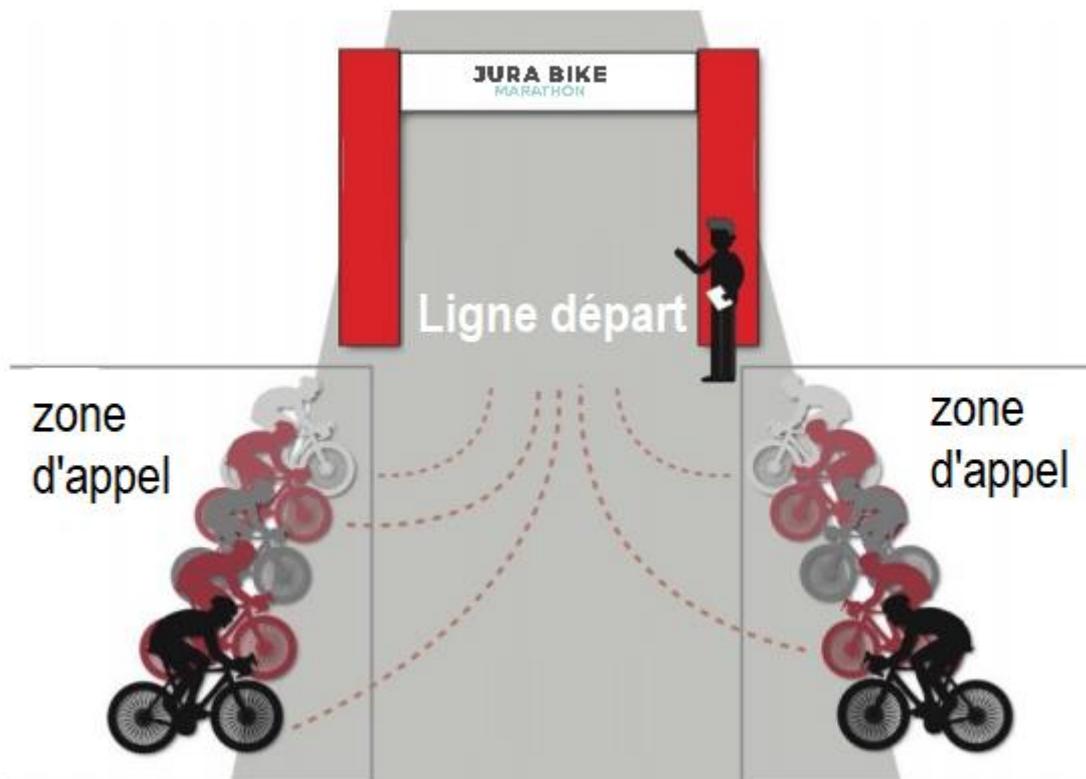
In the event of an accident, each competitor must provide assistance and remain with the injured person until medical personnel arrive.

6. Starting area & time barrier

All participants are requested to arrive on time at the start/finish line. A roll call will be conducted for the UCI Elite categories. For licensed women at 7:30 a.m. and for licensed men at 7:40 a.m.

Time barriers:

At km 43.1 at the Tech/Feed Zone in Les Auges after 4 hours and 15 minutes of racing for the men's categories and 4 hours and 35 minutes for the women's categories, i.e. at 12:15 p.m.



7. Team leaders' meeting

The schedule and meeting point for team managers is set for Saturday, 16 May at the race office when bibs are collected at the Halle des Fêtes in Vallorbe. The race office and UCI & Swiss Cycling commissaires are available to team managers for any information they may require.

8. Registration

Online registration is open until Wednesday, 14 May 2025 at 11:59 p.m. on the website of our timekeeper, SP Timing.

Late registrations for non-UCI licence holders are possible up to 60 minutes before the start of the race category.

9. Award ceremonies

The flower ceremonies will take place immediately after the arrival of the top three men and women in the XCM category.

The top ten in the XCM Elite Men and Women categories will be called to the official prize-giving ceremony, which will take place at around 3.30 p.m. **No prizes will be distributed before the prize-giving ceremony!**

For the other adult categories, the top three will be called.

For the youth categories, the top five in the various categories will be called.

Any changes will be announced by the announcer immediately after the race.

There are also many hotels in Vallée de Joux, Ballaigues, Orbe and Métabief (F). They are located close to the race area.

We are setting up a reserved area for coaches and motorhomes in the car park at Gare du Day, which is 1 km from the start. Toilets will be available, but there are no electrical hook-ups. Accompanying persons can take the bus from the Gare du Day station to the Poste Vallorbe stop (5 min journey). Don't forget to buy your ticket on the SBB app or at the ticket machines at the station.

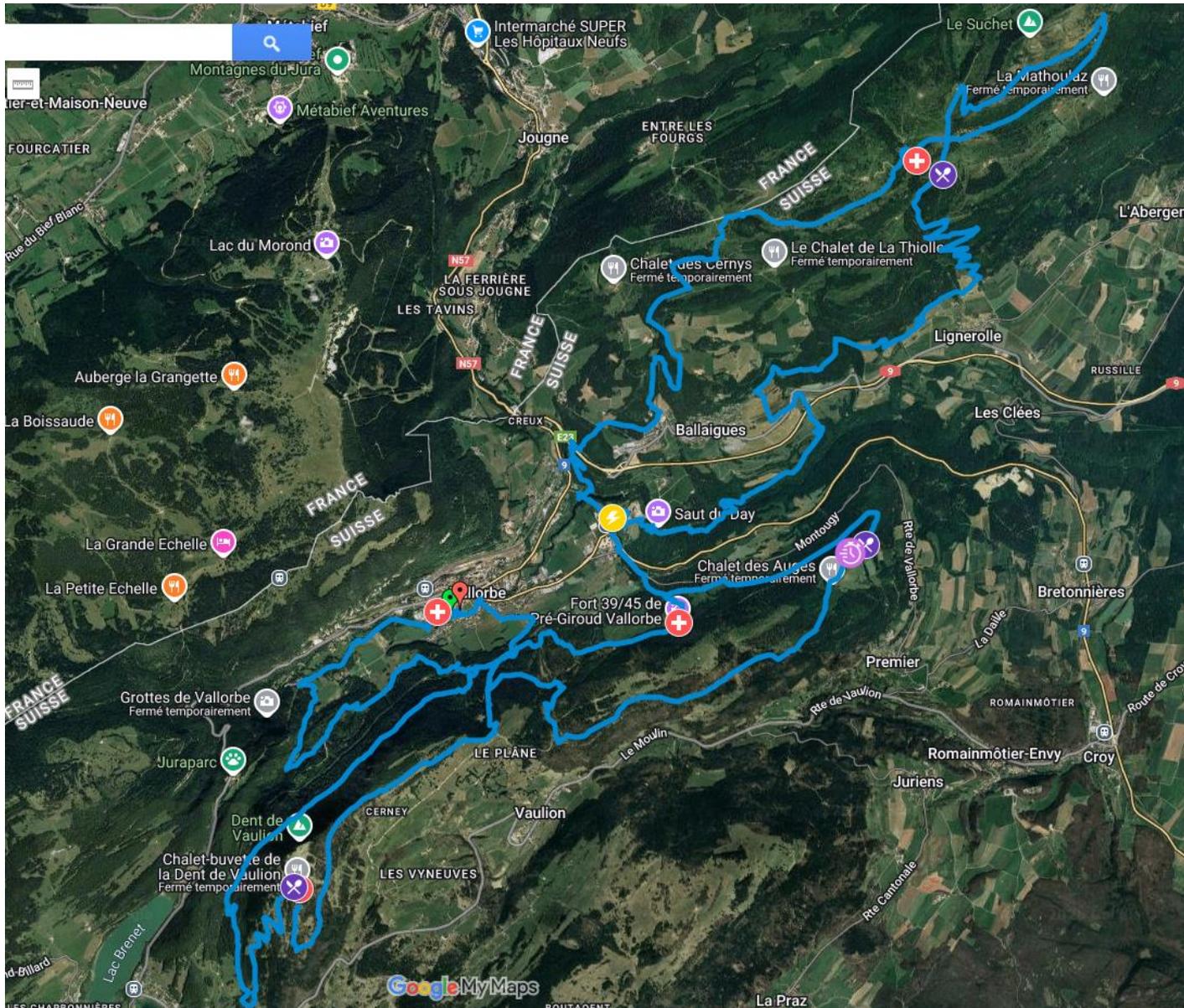
